

## Glamping & Camping FAQs

### **Q. How do I make a booking?**

### **Q. What is the cost?**

Campsites are \$35+hst/night. Glamping tents are \$135+hst/night or \$109/night in the off-season.

### **Q. What time is check-in?**

Check-in is any time after 3:00 pm. If there's a chance you will be later than 7:00 pm, we ask that you send us an email and then we will send you an email back with all the necessary check-in information because our shop closes at 7 pm.

### **Q. What time is check-out?**

A. Check-out is 11:00 am.

### **Q. What is included in the glamping tent?**

A. In each tent, there is a queen bed with linens and two twin cots with sleeping bags. There is also a cookware bin with a Coleman stove (fuel provided), a frying pan, pot, and dishes & cutlery for four people.

### **Q. What should I bring?**

All you need to bring are your clothes and food. Our glamping tents come with a queen bed and linens as well as towels. There is also a Coleman stove (fuel provided), a frying pan, pot, and dishes for four people. Note there is no refrigeration on site. You will need a cooler/ice to store your food.

### **Q. Do we need to bring a cooler or is there a fridge on site?**

A. If you are travelling with or bringing food that requires refrigeration, it's recommended that you bring a cooler with you. We do not have a fridge available for guests or power in the tents.

### **Q. Where is the nearest grocery store?**

The Margaree Co-op is located 1 km down the road. Exit our driveway and take a right. We also have a food truck on site, new this summer! Check it out Thursday-Saturday from 12:00-7:00 pm and Sunday from 9:00 am-12:00 pm.

### **Q. Are showers and washrooms on site?**

Yes, we have showers and washrooms on site. Our showers are a on demand propane heater system and have both hot and cold running water, and we have composting toilets on our campground.

**Q. Is there drinking water available?**

Yes, we have drinking water available on our campground located near the showers and some at our shop.

**Q. Is there power in the tents?**

No, the only power is down at our shop. We also have WIFI, which is available for our guests.

**Q. Are dogs allowed in the glamping tents?**

If you have booked a glamping site or are renting any of our camping gear, dogs are not permitted. If you've booked an unserviced campsite and are camping with your own gear, you are welcome to bring your dog so long as it remains on a leash while out on the grounds!

**Q. What is the cancellation policy?**

All glamping & campsite bookings are fully refundable up to 14 days prior to booking. If canceled between 14 and 7 days prior to booking, the deposit (50% of the total) will be forfeited. If canceled less than 7 days prior to booking, the full balance of the booking will not be refunded.

**Q. How many people can you have per camping site?**

For unserviced campsites there is a max of 4 people per site (including in glamping tents) and/or 2 tents per site. Glamping tents sleep 4 people max.

**Q. Is there a discount on tubing or any other activities if staying on site?**

If camping/glamping with us, there is a 10% discount on any of our water activities and rentals.
